In 2002 work began on planning the redevelopment of Augustinermuseum in line with contemporary requirements, the first and major phase of which was completed in 2010. The concept behind the conversion of and extension to the museum, which is housed in a former monastery, envisaged minimal intervention in the historical building fabric. The core idea was to recreate the original spatial effect through a second shell, thereby creating optimum exhibition space for the important collection of minster figures in the former monastery church
